
1.1. A Xing Wei Education

1.2. Student - Centered Education


Our goal is to move students beyond knowledge acquisition to self-led learning.

Xing Wei is focused on personalized teaching. This is first accomplished through small class sizes. The teacher-to-student ratio is 1:10.

In a small classroom, teachers can provide every students with a high-quality learning environment. To facilitate critical and innovative thinking, our seminar-style classes are interdisciplinary and internship oriented.

Our college desires that every student receives comprehensive and individualized instruction from its teachers.

Our teachers not only provide education in the classroom, they also work alongside of the student to help them pursue their interests and augment their talents. Students and mentors together work to manage the college, enhance campus life, and cultivate a global perspective. Student and mentors undertake this learning outside of the college campus by participating in cultural learning activities like visiting museums, concerts, farms, and ancient villages.




1.3. Xing Wei and the Liberal Arts

1.4. Our Campuses

Xing Wei is located in Shanghai, one of the most influential cities for global trade and technology. Xing Wei has two campuses. Our main campus is located in Nanhui and the second campus is located in the heart of the city of Shanghai.

The Nanhui campus covers an area of 354 hectares with beautiful canals and walking paths.

The Downtown campus is based in the WeWork coworking space where students can be in close contact with real startups and companies around Shanghai and China.

Our classrooms are equipped with all the resources necessary for an ideal learning environment. At Xing Wei, rather than traditional rows of desks and chairs, we prefer to organize our classrooms in circles to promote seminar-style mentor to student interaction.

At Xing Wei College, students and mentors live together. Our resident teachers interact with student outside of the classroom ensuring that learning, development and growth occurs in every area of our campus.

2.1. A supportive environment for collaboration and team learning



Collaborative Team Learning

Because traditional education systems focus on student's performance on standardized tests, they tend to neglect the student's ability to collaborate and work as a team.

At Xing Wei, however, we believe to thrive in the information era, students need to nurture their ability to work with each other to achieve common goals. Xing Wei College applies the Team Academy methodology from Finland, which has been nurturing team-entrepreneurs for the last 30 years. It has been proven to be effective in supporting students in developing leadership skills, team management skills, and fostering their creativity.



Student Self-Government

One key aspect of Xing Wei's learning philosophy is learning by doing. We accomplish this by putting **student in the center of college management**. All the major functions of the college are overseen by student-led committees, from facilities management to the hiring of faculty to campus activities

Through working in committee management, our students practice collective decision making, leadership, and have hands-on practice in organizational development.


2.4. Combining East and West education

International Business Management Major



The first year at Xing Wei is spent familiarizing yourself with what makes our school unique. Specialization liberal arts and introductory classes are held for all new students where they get a sample of what Xing Wei has to offer. These include but are not limited to the different student committees, core subjects and specializati -on exchanges with partner schools such as Shanghai Vancouver Film School, and Montessori.

Second year is when students start branching out from their introductory and core classes and experiment with all Xing Wei has to offer. From course creation to officially joining student committees, students play around with their curriculum and see what it is they wish to pursue. This is the year where also International Business majors start Team Academy and move downtown to begin their project-oriented learning.

In the third year, students continue with their custom curriculum and further build upon the courses they have chosen beforehand. This is also the year where students choose to explore a specialization offered in one of our exchange programs. We are partnered with multiple other universities and learning institutions, offering programs ranging from film production to business entre -preneurship. This is also the vear where most International Business students start their overseas experiences.


